Despite 50 years of public investments in education, health, and welfare...

• 38% of the adult population remains illiterate

And only...

- 12% of children are enrolled at the ECCE levels
- 76% at the primary
- 27% at the secondary
- 6% at the higher education level





Around 72 million secondary schoolaged young people and 30 million primary schoolaged children in Africa are outside the school system Without Skills Without training



What has been the return?


Have we built human capital?

More investments are needed to initiate and sustain health and education programs for children 0-8 years old.








4 Years to EFA/MDG




